**November 4 Sunday
DEPARTURE TO ISRAEL**

Today we depart from Chicago to Tel Aviv, Israel. Enjoy on-board meals and entertainment as we cross the Atlantic Ocean on our way to Israel.

**November 5 Monday
ARRIVE IN ISRAEL/GALILEE**

We arrive in Israel where we will be met by a representative who will assist us through customs. Drive to our hotel located by the Sea of Galilee with a short visit to Caesarea, once a proud Roman port city dating back to the time of Pontius Pilate. View the monumental Roman amphitheater built in the days of Christ. (Time permitting). A refreshing Jaffa orange juice will await you upon arrival to the hotel.

**November 6 Tuesday
MT. OF BEATITUDES/TABGHA/CAPERNAUM/ BOAT
& FISH LUNCH/GOLAN**

Breakfast in hotel. Our first stop this morning will be Mt. of Beatitudes. Near here Jesus gave the Beatitudes and taught on many occasions. Here he performed many of the miracles. We then proceed to Tabgha, where 5000 were fed by Jesus who performed the miracle of the multiplication of the fish and loaves. We continue to Capernaum, (Kfar Nahum), where much of the Galilean Ministry took place. Afterwards, enjoy a boat ride on the Sea of Galilee and hear how Jesus calmed the stormy sea and walked upon these water. Enjoy a St. Peter's fish lunch on the shores of the Sea of Galilee. We will now ascend the Golan Heights to view the Hula Valley and learn why the Golan Heights are so vital for Israel's security.

Overnight Ma'agan - Kibbutz (B/L/D)

**November 7 Wednesday
CANA/NAZARETH/MT. CARMEL/DRUZ VILLAGE**

Breakfast in hotel. This morning we begin our tour with a visit to Cana, the site of the first miracle, where Jesus turned water to wine. Continue to Nazareth where Jesus spent the silent years of his life and visit Mary's Well. We will now drive to Mt. Carmel to visit the traditional site of Muhraqa, where Elijah held a contest against the false prophets of Ba'al. A short drive takes us to Dalyat El Carmel Druz village, where unique handcraft is on display along the streets. You may enjoy the best Falafel in Israel here. We now return to our hotel, located by the Sea of Galilee.

**November 8 Thursday
BEIT SHEAN/MASADA/DEAD SEA/JERUSALEM**

Breakfast in hotel. Our tour begins with a visit to Beit Shean, often mentioned in the Bible. The bodies of Saul and his sons were hung on the city walls by the Philistines after the fateful battle on Mt. Gilboa. View the well-preserved mosaic floor and ancient ruins. From here we travel through the Jordan Valley to Masada. Ascend Masada by cable car. Your guide will explain the story of the Jewish Zealots that took their own lives rather than be sold into slavery.

Afterwards, descend Masada and continue to the Dead Sea for an optional float in the salty waters. We will now ascend the Judean Hills towards the eternal city of God - Jerusalem.

**November 9 Friday
SHRINE OF THE BOOK/MODEL/YAD VASHEM/
BETHLEHEM/GARDEN TOMB**

Breakfast in hotel. We begin the day with a visit to the Shrine of the Book, where the Dead Sea Scrolls are kept. View a miniature Model of ancient Jerusalem. Continue to Yad Vashem - Memorial to the six million Jews that lost their lives in the Holocaust. From here we drive to Bethlehem and visit the Church of Nativity and Manger Square. We end the day with a visit to the Garden Tomb, where a Communion service will be held.

**November 10 Saturday
MT. OF OLIVES/GETHSEMANE/OLD CITY OF
JERUSALEM:**

Breakfast in hotel. The Biblical and historical importance of the Old City of Jerusalem is known to Jews, Christians and Moslems alike. We begin the tour with a view of Jerusalem from the crest of Mt. of Olives. Today's walking tour includes: The Western Wall, Cardo, the Jewish Quarters, the Room of the Last Supper, St. Ann Church, Via Dolorosa, Oriental Bazaars and the Garden of Gethsemane, where Jesus was arrested.

PAYMENTS: All reservations for this tour are confirmed upon receipt of your Registration Form and a non-refundable deposit of \$200.00 per person. A second non-refundable deposit of \$200.00 per person is due June 1, 2012. Final payment is due September 15, 2012.

HOTEL ACCOMMODATIONS & SITES: All hotel accommodations are based on double occupancy with private bath. **NOTE:** We will attempt to find a roommate for single travelers desiring to share a room. However, if we are unable to find a roommate, or you do not accept our selection, the single room supplement will apply. The sequence of visits to sites may change according to the discretion of the tour operator and guide if they deem necessary. In case sequence is changed, all items on the itinerary will still be covered.

CANCELLATIONS & REFUNDS: The first deposit of \$200.00 per person and the second deposit of \$200.00 are non-refundable. Final payment is fully refundable, (excluding the non-refundable deposits of \$400.00 per person), until September 15, 2012. **Cancellations after September 15, 2012 become non-refundable and can only be recovered through a travel insurance policy. Please note that deposits and final payments for the tour cannot be changed from one person to another.** All cancellations **must** be made in writing to Heavenly Tours.
