Daily Itinerary:

WEDNESDAY JANUARY 4
DEPARTURE TO ISRAEL

Today we depart to Israel. Enjoy in-flight services as we cross the Atlantic Ocean on our way to Israel.

THURSDAY JANUARY 5
ARRIVE IN ISRAEL/TOUR OF JAFFA/ NETANYA

Arrive in Israel. Meet a representative who will assist you through customs. Meet your guide and proceed for a short tour of Jaffa. From here we drive to our hotel, located on the shores of the Mediterranean Sea. A refreshing Jaffa orange juice will be waiting for you upon arrival. (D)

FRIDAY JANUARY 6
**CAESAREA/MT.CARMEL/MEGIDDO/NAZARETH/
CANA/GAILEE**

After breakfast begin the tour with a visit to Caesarea, once a proud Roman port city dating back to the time of Pontius Pilate. View the monumental Roman amphitheater built in the days of Christ. Travel to Mt. Carmel, where Elijah held a contest against the false prophets of Baal. Next, travel to Megiddo, overlooking the plains of Armageddon and visit the site of the 21 superimposed cities. Travel to Nazareth where Jesus spent the silent years of his life and visit Mary's well. Afterwards, visit Cana, site of the first miracle where Jesus turned water to wine. We will now drive to our hotel by the Sea of Galilee. (B,D)

SATURDAY JANUARY 7
**MT. BEATITUDES/TABGHA/CHURCH OF
PRIMACY/CAPERNAUM/BOAT RIDE-FISH
LUNCH/KIBBUTZ TOUR**

After breakfast the first stop will be the Mt. Beatitudes. Near here Jesus gave the Beatitudes, taught on many occasions and performed many of the miracles. Travel to Tabgha, where Jesus performed the miracle of the multiplication of the fish and loaves and fed 5000. Nearby we will visit the Church of Primacy, where Jesus

appeared to his Disciples after his resurrection. Continue to Capernaum where much of the Galilean Ministry took place. Afterwards, enjoy a boat ride on the Sea of Galilee and hear how Jesus calmed the stormy sea and walked upon these waters. Enjoy a traditional St. Peter's fish lunch. We will now drive to Yardenit Baptismal site for optional Baptism in the Jordan River. We end the day with a tour of a Kibbutz to learn about this unique way of life. (B,L,D)

SUNDAY JANUARY 8

GOLAN VIEW/BEIT SHEAN/GIDEON SPRINGS/ EIN GEDI WATERFALLS/FREE AFTERNOON/ DEAD SEA

After breakfast we ascend the Golan Heights near Kibbutz Ein Gev. Our guide will explain why this area is so vital to Israel's security. Descend the Golan Heights and drive to Beit Shean to view the well-preserved mosaic floor and ancient ruins.

A short drive from here visit Gideon's Springs, where Gideon's soldiers drank the water before the faithful battle on Mt. Gilboa. From here we drive along the Jordan Valley to the Dead Sea area to see King David's Waterfalls. The rest of the day is free for rest, relaxation and optional float in the Dead Sea.

MONDAY JANUARY 9

MASADA/QUMRAN/TOMB OF LAZARUS/ JERUSALEM After breakfast we ascend Masada by cable car. Our guide will take us on a fascinating tour of this mountain where 960 Jewish defenders organized the last resistance to the Roman Conquerors. Descend Masada and travel to Qumran, the site where the Dead Sea Scrolls were discovered. We will now ascend the hills of Jerusalem to the "Eternal City of God" with a stop at the Tomb of Lazarus. (B,D)

TUESDAY JANUARY 10

MT. OF OLIVES/OLD CITY TOUR/WESTERN WALL/GARDEN OF GETHSEMANE/ CAIAPHAS' HOUSE & DUNGEON/ COURTYARD OF PETER'S DENIAL/ WESTERN WALL

At the start of the morning, drive to the crest of the Mt. of Olives, where The Old City Jerusalem and the Eastern Gate unfolds before us. We will now visit the Garden of Gethsemane, the high priest Caiaphas' House & Dungeon, the Courtyard of Peter's Denial, the Upper Room of the Last Supper and David's Tomb. Next is a walking tour of Old Jerusalem where you will enjoy the sites, sounds and aroma of 2000 years ago. We will also visit the Via Dolorosa, Western Wall, Cardo and the Pools of Bethesda. (B,D)

WEDNESDAY JANUARY 11

MODEL/SHRINE OF THE BOOK/ KNESSET/ YAD VASHEM/ BETHLEHEM & SHEPHERD'S FIELD/GARDEN TOMB

After breakfast we begin with a visit to a large outdoor model of the Herodian City of Jerusalem, dating back to the time of the Second Temple. Visit the Shrine of the Book, where the Dead Sea Scrolls are on display. Travel to the Knesset, (Israeli Parliament). Next we visit Yad Vashem, the memorial to the six million Jews that perished in the Holocaust. From here we travel to Bethlehem to visit the Church of the Nativity and

Manger Square. On our way back to Jerusalem a short visit to Shepherd's Field. Next, we drive to the Garden Tomb where a Communion Service will be held. (B,D)

RESERVATIONS & SCHEDULE OF

PAYMENTS: All reservations for this tour are confirmed upon receipt of your Registration Form and a non-refundable deposit of \$200.00 per person, which is due upon reservation and no later than May 1, 2011. Final payment is due November 1, 2011.

HOTEL ACCOMMODATIONS & SITES: All hotel accommodations are based on double occupancy with private bath. **NOTE:** We will attempt to find a roommate for single travelers desiring to share a room. However, if we are unable to find a roommate, or you do not accept our selection, the single room supplement will apply. The sequence of visits to sites may change according to the discretion of the tour operator and guide if they deem necessary. In case sequence is changed, all items on the itinerary will still be covered.

CANCELLATIONS & REFUNDS: The deposit of \$200.00 is non-refundable. Final payment is fully refundable, (excluding the non-refundable deposit of \$200.00 per person), until November 1, 2011. **Cancellations after November 1, 2011 become non-refundable and can only be recovered through a travel insurance policy.** Please note that deposits and final payments for the tour cannot be changed from one person to another. All cancellations must be made in writing to Heavenly International Tours. Travel insurance is highly recommended.

UNUSED SERVICES: No refund will be available for unused touring, meals or any other program components stated in the itinerary.

PASSPORT, VISA & VACCINATIONS: Valid passport for 6 months after the tour has ended is required. No vaccinations or visa are required from U.S. Citizens to enter Israel.
