WEDNESDAY, MARCH 10 DEPARTURE FLIGHT TO ISRAEL

Today we depart from Chicago to Tel Aviv, Israel.

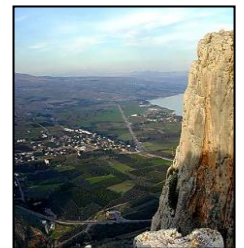
THURSDAY, MARCH 11 ARRIVE IN ISRAEL/TEL AVIV

Arrive in Israel. Meet a representative who will assist us through customs. Meet our guide and proceed for a short walking tour of Jaffa and then to our hotel, located on the shores of the Mediterranean Sea. A refreshing Jaffa orange juice will be waiting for us upon arrival.

FRIDAY, MARCH 12 CAESAREA/MT. CARMEL/MEGIDDO/ NAZARETH/CANA/GALILEE

After breakfast we drive to Caesarea, once a proud Roman port city dating back to the time of Pontius Pilate. View the monumental Roman amphitheater built in the days of Christ. Travel to Mt. Carmel, where Elijah held a contest against the false prophets of Baal. Next, travel to Megiddo, overlooking the plains of Armageddon and visit the site of the 21 superimposed cities. Travel to Nazareth where Jesus spent the silent years of his life and visit Mary's Well. Afterwards, visit Cana, site of the first miracle where Jesus turned water to wine. We will now drive to our hotel in the Galilee.

SATURDAY, MARCH 13 MT. BEATITUDES/ TABGHA/ CAPERNAUM/ BOAT RIDE-FISH LUNCH/BAPTISMAL SITE

After breakfast our first stop will be Mt. Beatitudes. Near here Jesus gave the Beatitudes and taught on many occasions. Here he also performed many of the miracles. Travel to Tabgha, where 5000 were fed by Jesus who performed the miracle of the multiplication of the fish and loaves.

Continue to Capernaum where much of the Galilean Ministry took place. Afterwards, enjoy a boat ride on the Sea of Galilee and hear how Jesus calmed the stormy sea and walked upon these waters. Enjoy a traditional St. Peter's fish lunch. From here we continue to Yardenit Baptismal site on the Jordan River, where time will be available for an optional baptismal service.

SUNDAY, MARCH 14

**CAESARIA PHILIPPI/GOLAN VIEW/
KORAZIM/GIDEON SPRINGS/BEIT SHEAN**

After breakfast we ascend the Golan Heights. Our guide will explain why this area is so vital to Israel's security. We continue to Caesarea Philippi. From here we drive to Gideon Springs, the site where Gideon's soldiers drank the water before the faithful battle on Mt. Gilboa. From here we drive to Beit Shean and view the well-preserved mosaic floor and Byzantine city.

MONDAY, MARCH 15

**MASADA/DEAD SEA/VIEW OF EIN GEDI
WATERFALLS/QUMRAN/JERUSALEM**

After breakfast we drive through the Jordan Valley to Masada. Ascend Masada by cable car. Our guide will take us on a fascinating tour of this mountain where 960 Jewish defenders organized the last resistance to the Roman Conquerors. Descend Masada and travel to the Dead Sea for an optional float in the salty waters. We continue to view Ein Gedi waterfalls followed by a short visit to Qumran, the site where the Dead Sea Scrolls were discovered. We will now ascend the hills of Jerusalem towards the "Eternal City of God".

TUESDAY, MARCH 16

**MT. OF OLIVES/ CARDO/WAILING WALL/
GARDEN OF GETHSEMANE**

After breakfast visit the Old City of Jerusalem. The Biblical and historical importance of Jerusalem is known to Jews, Christians and Moslems alike. At the start of the morning, drive to the crest of Mt. of Olives where the entire city of Jerusalem unfolds before us. Today's walking tour includes: Garden of Gethsemane, Pools of Bethesda, Upper Room of the Last Supper, Ecce Homo Arch, Via Dolorosa, Church of the Holy Sepulcher, Wailing Wall, Cardo, Jewish Quarters and Oriental Bazaars. We end the day at Gethsemane, believed to be the site where Jesus and his disciples prayed the night before Jesus' crucifixion.

WEDNESDAY, MARCH 17

**MODEL/SHRINE OF THE BOOK/CITY OF
DAVID/HEZEKIAH TUNNEL/GARDEN TOMB**

After breakfast we begin with a visit to a Model of the Herodian city of Jerusalem, dating back to the time of the Second Temple. Visit the nearby Shrine of the Book where the Dead Sea Scrolls are on display. From here we continue for a visit of the City of David and walk through Hezekiah Tunnel.

Next we drive to the Garden Tomb where a communion service will be held. **(B/D)**

RESERVATIONS & SCHEDULE OF

PAYMENTS: All reservations for this tour are confirmed upon receipt of your Registration Form and a non-refundable deposit of \$200.00 per person, which is due upon reservation and no later than June 15, 2009. A second non-refundable deposit of \$200.00 is due September 1, 2009. Final payment is due January 10, 2010.

HOTEL ACCOMMODATIONS & SITES: All hotel accommodations are based on double occupancy with private bath. **NOTE:** We will attempt to find a roommate for single travelers desiring to share a room. However, if we are unable to find a roommate, or you do not accept our selection, the single room supplement will apply. The sequence of visits to sites may change according to the discretion of the tour operator and guide if they deem necessary. In case sequence is changed, all items on the itinerary will still be covered.

CANCELLATIONS & REFUNDS: The Initial Deposit and Second Deposit are non-refundable. Final payment is fully refundable, (excluding the non-refundable deposits of \$400.00 per person), until January 10, 2010. **Cancellations after January 10, 2010 become non-refundable and can only be recovered through a travel insurance policy.** Please note that deposits and final payments for the tour cannot be changed from one person to another. All cancellations must be made in writing to Heavenly International Tours. Travel insurance is highly recommended.
